What Is The Mentorship Program?

The Ohio Girls Golf Foundation (OGGF) is excited to partner with the Northern Ohio Golf Association to introduce the Middle School Mentorship Program, designed to connect high school golfers with middle school girls interested in learning or advancing their golf skills through clinics led by experienced instructors.



The clinics will be structured around skill stations, each focusing on a different aspect of the game, such as driving, chipping, putting, and on-course management.

To enhance learning and keep participants engaged, fun contests and interactive activities will be incorporated throughout the session. All clinics will be led by LPPGA & PGA Instructors, who will ensure high-quality instruction and development. We plan to maintain a 6:1 participant-to-instructor ratio in each clinic.



Benefits of Program

The objectives of the Middle School Mentorship Program are to provide meaningful mentorship opportunities by pairing high school golfers with middle school girls. The program aims to foster skill development among middle school participants, welcoming both beginners and those with prior experience in the game. It encourages positive, confidence-building experiences that nurture a lifelong interest in golf. In addition, the program offers high school players a chance to earn community service hours through their participation. Ultimately, the goal is to establish, develop, and maintain a strong pipeline of middle school golfers to sustain and grow participation in girls' high school golf teams.



Who Can Participate?

The program is open to middle school girls in grades 6 through 8 who are interested in learning the game of golf or building on their existing skills. It also welcomes high school golfers who are eager to serve as mentors and give back to the game by supporting and inspiring the next generation of young female golfers.

High School Golf Coach's Responsibility

High school golf coaches will play an integral role in recruiting and encouraging their team players to participate in the program.

We ask each Coach to recruit your team Captain to participate in the clinics as a "Mentor".

Because we know that high school golf coaches have their finger on the pulse of girls golf prospects, we also ask you to help recruit middle school girls from the community.



High School Player (Mentor) Responsibility

High school players will take on the important role of guiding the middle school mentees during golf clinics, helping to create a supportive and positive learning environment. Through their participation and mentorship, each Mentor will receive a Swag Bag full of great gifts, your clinic participation could also count for community service hours, recognizing their commitment to leadership and giving back to the game.

How to Participate

Participating girls will be invited to attend a Sunday afternoon clinics from 4 pm - 5 pm held at area golf facilities in Northern Ohio.
